- Create an Apple ID for your child
 - **Name@icloud.com**
- Added Apple Family
- Age-based parental controls, and they can use Family Sharing, Messages, the App Store and other Apple services.



Apple Devices

New iPhone or iPad

- Use the child Apple ID to setup the device.
- The device will then appear in the Apple Family Screen.

Existing iPhone or iPad

Goto Settings and sign in with the child Apple ID

Benefits

- Age-related restrictions for content in apps, books, TV shows, and movies
- Downtime and limits for specific apps
- Restrictions for who your child can communicate with
- Approvals for purchases or free downloads
- See the device Location





Add the Child's Google Account to **Family Link**





Existing Google accounts can also be added

- The minimum age to create an account on the following is 13 years old
- **WhatsApp**
- **Facebook**
- **TikTok**
- **SnapChat**
- These will all have Security features that will allow control and I would recommend to view these online

**All data entered into any Social Media platform is kept!
Whether deleted from personal devices.**
