### <u>Safeguarding: A Window Into Young Children and the Online Space – Ofcom</u>

According to Ofcom's annual study of children's relationship with the media and online worlds, 24% of 5 to 7 year olds own a smartphone.

If the definition of devices is widened to tablets, that figure rises to 76%.

A third of those surveyed use social media unsupervised.

Please be vigilant.

If your child uses a tablet or smart phone, ensure the settings are for children rather than adults, to ensure they cannot access inappropriate material.

Check your child's devices every day to see what they have been accessing.

#### Is my child too ill for school?

You might have noticed that there is currently a big push by the Government, with support from the NHS, to decrease avoidable absence in schools.

The NHS has a useful page that helps parents and carers decide whether a child is well enough to attend school.

Along with the Chief Medical Officer, the NHS say it is usually appropriate for parents and carers to send their children to school with mild respiratory illnesses, including general cold symptoms like a minor cough, runny nose or sore throat. Without an accompanying high temperature, a child would be expected to attend school.
