

Place Planning consultation:


I am writing to you to notify you of the consultation to raise the Published Admission Number (PAN) of The Rackham Church of England Primary School and Pre-School. This is a separate process to the recent Planning consultation to physically expand the school's premises, and is being carried out in line with the Department of Education guidance that states a Local Authority must publicly consult on any changes that are permanent (defined by the DfE as being for more than three years), and increase the capacity of the school by more than 30 pupils and more than 25% or the overall capacity.

The consultation shall run from 10/11/2025 to 08/12/2025.


















Uniform orders:
