

# **English**

Our Pathways to Write unit this half term will be inspired by the book 'The Lost Happy Endings' by Carol Ann Duffy and Jane Ray. We will be writing a traditional tale from another point of view. Our Pathways to Read unit will be Hansel and Gretel by Neil Gaiman and Lorenzo Mattotti. In spelling, we will be focusing on apostrophes, prefixes and homophones.

### Maths
