What is the Phonics Screening Check?

The phonics screening check (PSC) is a statutory assessment for primary schools in the 2023/24 academic year.

How is it administered?


From the DfE guidance:

Teachers will assess students on their phonics decoding ability.


Students will be asked to read out 40 items with a teacher. These items will be a mix of real words and pseudo-words (alien words). The teacher will then score each item (1 mark for a correct answer) and total the scores to make up the mark for the screening check.
