- Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy as well the expectations outlined in this agreement;
- Communicate between home and school through notices, newsletters, emails and the school website;
- Update parents about relevant and recent Government legislation that applies to our school;
- Always put the safety and welfare of our pupils, staff and community at the heart of our decision making.

## **Parent**

#### Parent/Carer:

#### To help my child at school, I understand that:

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school;
- If my child, or another child in the group, shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately;
- On my commute, and when dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules:
- When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the school timings for my child;
- My child must not bring any items into school with them or take items home from school:
- My child will have their temperature taken during the day if they feel or present as being unwell
- I will need to remind my child about social distancing rules but accept they are difficult to follow and that my child may not always do this successfully;
- My child will need to use good respiratory and hand hygiene;
- I will ensure my children wear clean clothing every day and that they have washed between each school day;
- I will not be allowed into the school without a prearranged appointment;
- I will read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home;
- I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carer and emergency contacts details;
- I understand that if my child is deemed unsafe, he/she will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe;
- I will ensure my child does not take any bags into school and that packed lunches will be placed in a disposable bag every day.

#### I will do my best to:

- Adhere to the social distancing rules in class and in the playground;
- Tell an adult if I feel unwell;
- Travel (or walk) to and from school with an adult every day and not on my own or with friends;
- Not bring things into school from home, or take things home from school:
- Only use the equipment provided to me by school and no other;
- Not mix with children from other bubbles in the school;
- Only enter and exit the school building from the designated gates and doorways;
- Follow good respiratory hygiene: coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue (catch it-bin it-kill it);
- Follow good hand hygiene use soap and water for 20 seconds/ hand sanitiser;
- Always behave well to maintain the safety of myself and others:
- Follow these expectations and know that if I don't, I will be sent home and will not be able to come back into school until I can be safe;
- Understand that these changes are about keeping everyone safe, including me.


This will be a difficult transition but will enable our now virtual community to slowly begin re-connecting in person, and what a wonderful thing that will be.
