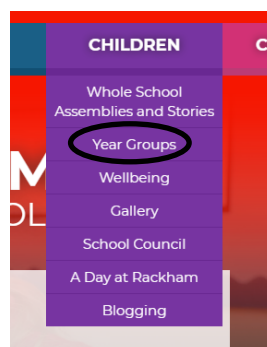


Seesaw is the most important app for your child to engage with.

Each individual child has their own login code and via this they can access activities, videos and messages posted by their teacher. As regularly as possible, we would like you to upload any photos, videos, messages or documents of any work or activities you have completed at home. Please note, this does not have to be activities sent out by the school. The teachers LOVE seeing what you have been up to and feel most connected with the pupils via Seesaw. They check their accounts daily and will respond to all posts either through 'liking' and approving it or leaving a longer comment. Sometimes, they may reply verbally or help a child to edit work and send it back to you.

Haven't used it yet? Just ask your child's class teacher (via email) for help and advice.

Using the drop down Children menu and then clicking on 'year groups', you will be able to access all work sent out by the teachers. This includes resource sheets, answers to questions and links to useful websites or PWP activities.

Please note, teachers are not able to upload help videos via the website as easily as using Seesaw, so to access all work these two platforms should be used in conjunction with each other.
