## **Guidance for Parents and Carers whose Children travel to and from School via Taxi**

The notes of Guidance for Students and Parents/Carers entitled to school and social care transport clearly states that parents/carers are responsible for the student's behaviour in the following events:

- Before they get in the vehicle
- During the journey
- After they leave the vehicle

They will be informed if students harass or bully others, fight, are offensive, cause vandalism or throw objects. If students cause damage to the vehicle or other property, the cost of repairing the damage may be charged to the parent/carer. Remember students will lose their right to use the school transport if they misbehave and parents/carers may have to pay for alternative transport, or bring the child to school themselves.

We want students to enjoy their journey to school. However, parents/carers should encourage their children to refrain from distracting the driver as this could put the passengers and other road users at risk.

If you need to change the address of where your son is being collected from you must fill in an 'Application for change of address form' and allow up to 10 working days for this to process.

We will take responsibility for the students once the taxi arrives on school property and before the taxi leaves the school grounds.
