History

Overview

Students of Entry Level Certificate in History will develop their knowledge and understanding of the past, investigate historical events, people and developments, and use historical sources to answer key questions.

GCSE students complete a thematic study over time on either crime or medicine, followed by a period study and British depth study chosen from students' area of interest. Finally, students undertake a modern depth study of either Nazi Germany or the USA's conflicts, home and abroad, between 1954 and 1975.

Assessment

For Entry Level students complete three pieces of assessed written work
