



KS2 SATs results 2019

In 2019 the assessment performance of Ramsden Hall Academy has not been rated by the Dfe because the small number of students sitting the assessments means our progress scores will be more greatly impacted by the performance of individual students when compared to other schools and academies with larger numbers of students sitting the assessments.

Students may enrol at Ramsden Hall Academy at any point during the academic year, although the majority of students in Year 6 will have first joined at the start of the academic year. Prior to joining us the majority of our students will have experienced significant disruption to their full-time primary education as a result of exclusions, reduced timetabled provision or long-term absence from education. As a consequence of this disruption to their education and/or their Special Educational Needs a significant percentage of our students are unable to access the Key Stage 2 assessments at the end of Year 6.
