NO SMOKING

The SLT carry out random searches at arrival time, confiscate any smoking materials and inform parents/carers. Students who refuse to be searched may not be allowed on site.

Students who are seen smoking on school grounds are offered 1:1 support from one of our trained smoking cessation advisers

If they refuse this they receive an educational detention to show them the dangers to their health and parents and carers are informed

Parents and carers of students who are repeatedly seen smoking in school grounds are be invited into school to meet with a member of SLT to agree a support plan for their son.
