Curriculum Intent *for* MFL

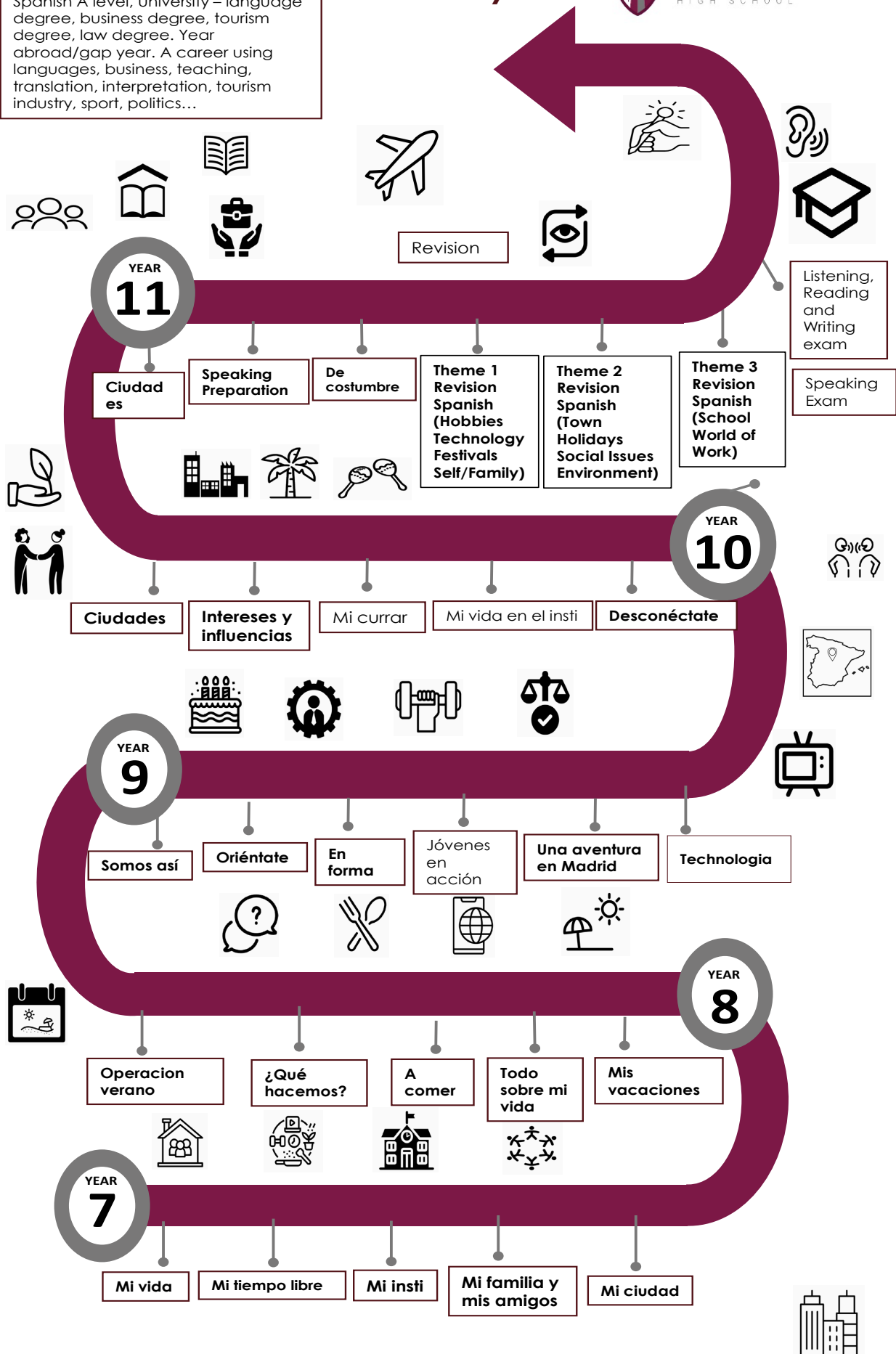
