

RE: Year 11 Alton Towers Trip

Dear Families,

We are delighted to be able provide details about the proposed Year 11 Reward Trip to Alton Towers. We are intending to run this trip for Year 11 as recognition of the hard work and positive attitude they have shown since their return to school in September.

The trip will be going on Friday 21st October. We plan to set-off from school at around 8:30am which will ensure we arrive at the theme park for just after opening time. We will then depart from the park at around 6:00pm. This will give learners a full day to enjoy the rides and the other events that are taking place as part of the Alton Towers Scarefest. Learners will not be required to wear their uniform for this trip.

The trip will cost approximately £30 per learner which will cover the cost of travel and the entry to the park. The school are subsidising some of the cost to enable us to keep the cost down to £30. There may be a slight change in this price depending on the number of students who choose to go on the trip.

Access to the trip will be dependent on the points listed below:

Students must:

- Have a positive Excellence and Behaviour points score for this year up to 10th October. This can be found on the Class Charts app.
- Attendance of 95%+ (genuine periods of illness will not count against this)
- No exclusions
- Positive attitude towards school and lessons.

If you are unsure about any of these points please contact the school to discuss them with us. At this point we need to gather an idea of the number of students who would like to go on this trip so that we can then confirm final costings and arrangements.
