5	Do furniture layouts allow easy movement for students with disabilities?				Yes – review smaller classrooms
6	Are quiet rooms/calming rooms available to children who need this facility?				Yes – further development of sensory room is in planning stages.
7	Are car park spaces reserved for disabled people near the main entrance?				The car park spaces are in front of the Astley Sports Village entrance, review to have some at the front of school.
8	Are there barriers to ease movement around the site and to the main entrance?				Yes
9	Are steps needed for access to the main entrance?				No
10	Do all those steps have a contrasting colour edging?				Not required to access main entrance, but in other areas around school these are evident.
11	If there are steps, is a ramp provided to access the main entrance				N/A
12	Is there a continuous handrail on each ramp and stair flight and landing to the main entrance?				Yes
13	Is it possible for a wheelchair user to get through the main door unaided?				Yes

18	Does each block have a wheelchair accessible toilet?	Second floor doesn't have an accessible toilet
19	Does the relevant block have accessible changing rooms/shower facilities?	Yes
20	If the block is on more than one level, do the internal steps/stairs have contrast colour edgings?	Yes
21	Is there a continuous handrail on each internal stair flight and landing?	Yes
22	Do all areas of school have a lift that can be used by wheelchair users?	Yes
23	Do you have any sort of mechanical means provided to move between floors? If, yes please state.	Lift
24	Is it possible for a wheelchair user to use all the fire exits from areas to which they have access?	Yes they would have an accessible fire exit, but a contingency plan is needed in the event of a fire for if they are on the second floor as there are stairs to access the nearest fire exit.
25	Are non-visual guides used to assist people to use the buildings?	Not in place
26	Could any of the signage or displays be confusing or disorientating for students with disabilities?	
27	Is a hearing induction loop available (either fixed or portable) in the school?	Not in place
28	Do emergency alarm systems cater for those with hearing impairment? (e.g. flashing light)	This would need to be reviewed for suitability for any student joining with significant hearing impairment but the current system allows for students to be alerted visually by Staff.
