Students are encouraged to take responsibility for their own learning and conduct at Rayner Stephens and this ensures we have both a productive and purposeful learning environment.



Rayner Stephens students are offered an extensive range of extra-curricular and enrichment activities and have access to the best sport and leisure facilities in the borough.

Students benefit from a very successful sports programme which includes football, rugby, handball, basketball, tennis, badminton, table tennis, rounders, softball, athletics and cricket amongst others. They have access to outstanding on-site sporting facilities both at Astley Sports Village and at Ashton Sixth Form College and extensive partnerships with local sporting organisations.

As well as our broad extra-curricular offer, we provide lots of opportunities for our students to develop leadership skills, as well as participating in a range of curriculum linked and competitive activities across Stamford Park Trust.

We also offer a diverse range of clubs that are for fun and enjoyment including the Duke of Edinburgh Award Bronze and silver to learning British sign language.




