RE: Strike Action and Year 8 and SEND Parent/Carer Celebration and Progress Evening

Dear parents and carers

The next two planned days for strike action by the National Education Union are due to be held on **Thursday 27th April and Tuesday 2nd May**. I am now in a position to be able to provide full details about what will happen on the first of these days (Thursday 27th April).

In its ongoing campaign for a fully funded, above inflation pay rise, teacher members of the National Education Union in England and Wales have voted overwhelmingly for strike action. Thursday 27th April and Tuesday 2nd May are the next two proposed strike days.

Due to the number of teaching staff who will be supporting the campaign as members of the National Education Union and who will be taking strike action on Thursday 27th April, **we will only be open to year 11, year 10 and year 7 students on Thursday 27th April.** It is compulsory that these two-year groups attend school on these days. Full plans for the second day (Tuesday 2nd May) will be communicated early next week.

Year 8 and SEND Parent/Carer Evening – Thursday 27th April Date Change

Due to the strike action taking place next Thursday we have had to take the decision to move the Year 8 Parent/Carer Celebration and Progress Evening and the SEND Parent/Carer Evening taking place. Both events will move to the following Thursday (4th May). All appointment times will just be rolled over to that evening but you can amend appointment times if necessary by logging back into your School Cloud account.

I appreciate the inconvenience this may cause to students and families in years 8 and 9; however, I also recognise and feel it is vitally important that the national campaign for a fully funded, above inflation pay rise for teaching and support staff receives the support required from the school and our decision to close to three year groups is in line with a significant number of other secondary and primary schools.

In order to support the families of student in years 8 and 9 who may require childcare on the day of strike action, we will be opening the school to the groups of students listed below in addition to all of year 11, year 10 and year 7. If you require a place in school for your child under any of the criteria below, can I please request that you complete the form on the link **by 5pm on Tuesday 25th April**. This will allow us to plan out the correct supervision and support for the number of students we will have onsite.

The students who are eligible for a place in school on Thursday 27th April are:

- All of year 11, year 10 and year 7 students (compulsory attendance for these three year groups)
- Any children in years 8 and 9 and classed as vulnerable for a particular factor identified by the school. (School will contact these families prior to the strike days)
