RE: Partial School Closure: School Closed to Learners in Year 10 on Monday 30th November 2020

Further to my letter yesterday, I am writing to advise families that we continue to face the same challenge in relation to staffing capacity as we have done today. Consequently, I have taken the difficult decision to close the school to all learners in Year 10 on Monday 30th November 2020.

Please note, this closure is due to staffing capacity and not individual learner's contact with any confirmed cases of coronavirus. This is a school closure for these learners, not a period of self-isolation

Due to the level of staff absence we are unable to provide 'Live' lessons and are directing parents and learners to access the remote learning on our website.

Year 10 learners who are eligible for free school meals will be issued with a voucher equal in value to the daily free school meal allowance for the period of this partial school closure.

The issues impacting on secondary schools due to Covid-19 change daily. We are expecting the issue with staffing to resolve itself early next week so that all learners can attend school as normal. We will be monitoring this situation carefully and if further closure to year groups is required after Monday, we would select a different year group so that the impact is equally shared across Years 7-10. In this eventuality, I will write to all families again.

No Head Teacher ever wants to have to close their school and I can assure families that this decision has not been taken lightly. Should you have any concerns, please do not hesitate to contact school.
