Learners must arrive at school with a face covering, wearing this as they enter the school building.



Once learners have been tested they will resume their normal timetable and remain in school for the rest of the day.

Where learners are absent on the day they are due to return, they should report to the ASV reception at 8:45 on their first day back at school after the period of absence so that testing can be undertaken.
