

Dear families,

The Government has just announced a staggered return in January for secondary school student in Years 7-10. Year 11 will return on Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> January with the BTEC/Vocational exams taking place as published starting 7<sup>th</sup> January. Learners classed as vulnerable or the parents of key workers in Years 7-10 will have access to learning in school from Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> January all other learners in Years 7-10 will access remote learning, not returning to school until Monday 11<sup>th</sup> January 2021.

Tier 3	Year 11 learners will continue to access school full time.
	There will be full-time on-site provision to vulnerable children and the children
	of critical workers in Years 7-10 only.
	Remote education to be provided for all other learners in Years 7-10.
	All learners and adults will be required to wear face mask when moving around school and in communal areas.
	When learners are not on the rota to be in school remote education will be provided.

The timing of this announcement has come late today, please bear with us while we put our contingency plan in place. Members of the inclusion team will contact parents of learners categorised as vulnerable and parents with key worker status tomorrow. If you are a keyworker and have not informed the school of your status please contact keyworker@rshs.aspireplus.org.uk (please refer to the Government definition of key worker). I will write to you again tomorrow with further information and guidance on the remote learning timetable for Years 7-10.
