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Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you for your continued support and patience during this pandemic. As you may be aware we have a number of pupils and staff self isolating, following positive tests results for themselves or due to being identified as close contacts.

Public Health England have confirmed the cases in school are a result of pupils being in contact with positive cases in the community.

School continues to follow all government guidance to help keep our school community safe.

Please can I remind you of my letter, dated 28th June, which asked all parents and carers to:

- 1) Keep their child at home if any of the family have any signs or symptoms of Covid.
- 2) Keep their child at home if any of the family are waiting for results of a PCR Covid test.
- 3) Remember, even if you are double vaccinated you can still catch and spread Covid.

In addition:

- 1) If you are testing members of your family, please complete these tests before you put your child on school transport.
- 2) If your child is sick, and it is possible, a lateral flow test is required before they return to school.
