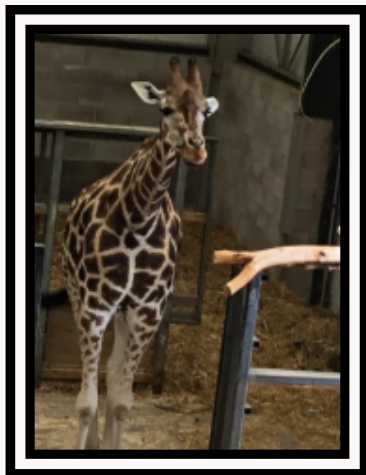

### What is the Summer Reading Challenge?
