It's been another exciting and eventful week at RLA as we wrapped up the final week of the half term – and what a busy four days it's been!

This week, the children thoroughly enjoyed Careers Week. It was fantastic to welcome so many visitors into school to share their jobs and career journeys. The enthusiasm and curiosity from the children were wonderful to see!

We also celebrated excellent attendance by awarding badges to children who achieved 95% attendance or higher. You may have noticed two large new additions to our school roof – heat pumps! As part of a decarbonisation project, RLA has received significant funding to upgrade our heating system. These improvements will help reduce our carbon footprint and make our school more sustainable. The work is ongoing, with many of our older radiators being replaced with new, energy-efficient heat coil radiators. We're also having solar panels installed as part of the project.

Finally, as the days are becoming colder, when the children return after half term, please ensure your child wears a suitable coat every day.

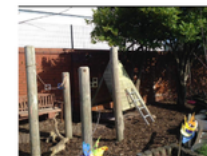
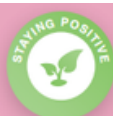
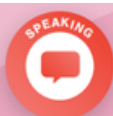

## Revoe Learning Academy Nursery

We offer free early education for children who access the Government funded 2 year old and 3-4 year old, 15 and 30 hour scheme.

The children are cared for by an experienced Nursery Teacher and highly qualified Nursery Practitioners. Through attending Nursery, children have access to a wide variety of experiences and resources. We encourage children to be curious learners, providing an environment rich in reading opportunities and conversation, with an emphasis on learning through play. Our planning follows the children's interests with focused group times, such as Dough Disco, Maths, Early Phonics, Music and Movement, to support children in being Reception ready.

Children who access the 15-hour scheme can attend:

1. Either morning or afternoon sessions, Monday to Friday (3 hours per day),
2. Monday 8.40 am until 3.10 pm, Tuesday 8.40 am until 3.10 pm and Wednesday 8.40 am until 11.40 am,
3. Wednesday 12.10 pm until 3.10 pm, Thursday 8.40 am until 3.10 pm and Friday 8.40 am until 3.10 pm.

Children who access the 30-hour scheme attend Monday to Friday, 8.40 am until 3.10 pm.
