Welcome to Issue 678 of the Revoe Reporter! It has been a very busy week in school, with lots of exciting opportunities for the children across different year groups. Year 6 have had some particularly memorable experiences. Class 6AC enjoyed a trip to Hangar 42, where they explored wartime history and saw real aircraft and artefacts. Meanwhile, 6SH visited Anchorsholme Academy to meet author Matt Goodfellow, who shared his writing, inspiring the children and encouraging their own creativity. In addition, Network Rail visited school to deliver a safety workshop, helping the children understand how to stay safe around railways. Year 6 also had the opportunity to take part in a virtual reality experience, which brought this learning to life in an engaging and memorable way.

Year 4 visited Martin Mere and had a fantastic time learning about wildlife and the natural environment. The children were fully engaged throughout the visit and really enjoyed the opportunity to learn outside the classroom. Thank you to all staff who organised and supported these trips and visits – they make a real difference to the children's learning and enjoyment.

Across Key Stage 2, pupils took part in First Aid workshops, where they learned important life skills such as how to respond in an emergency and how to perform CPR. These sessions were extremely valuable in helping children understand how they can help keep themselves and others safe and how to stay calm in difficult situations.

We also welcomed the RNLI, who delivered water safety talks to the children. With the warmer weather and recent incidents involving children and water, this is a very important message. We would appreciate your support in reinforcing these safety messages at home, particularly around being careful near the sea, lakes and open water. Thank you to Miss Finlay for organising all of these valuable workshops and experiences.

Finally, our Year 2 children have worked extremely hard this week in their SATs. We are very proud of their effort, determination and positive attitude throughout.

We have noticed that attendance has dipped slightly this week. Please remember how important it is for children to be in school every day and to arrive on time, as this has a big impact on their learning and progress. Thank you for your continued support.

Tasha from the Awaken team was in school today to deliver workshops around internet safety with groups of children in year 6. Tasha spoke with the children about how to stay safe using social media and whilst using the internet. This was a very valuable refresher for the children especially as they move up to year seven. Tasha complimented the way the children took part in the sessions and praised their behaviour - well done year six and keep safe online!!! Have a restful weekend, everyone.

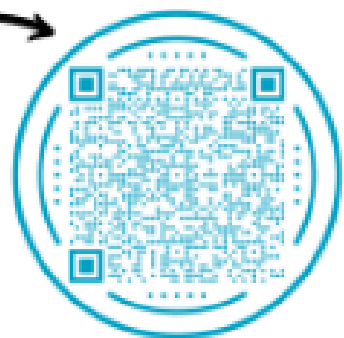
Blackpool Carers have a special Young Carers Team that can help and support you.
