Excellent Learning and Homework Habits for Home to Do

- PE days and has swimming kit if swimming.
- ✓ All other days, dress your child in our correct school uniform so that your child feels that they belong to the Revoe family.
- Support your child with their homework by providing a quiet place in your home for them to complete tasks.
- Find 5 mins on 3 nights or mornings to listen to your child read and ask them to talk about what they have read.

Excellent Attendance and Punctuality Habits for Home to Embed

- We reward good and excellent attendance with a range of rewards including parties and family vouchers.
- Your child must attend school and be on time as much as is possible.
- If your child is absent for minor or unacceptable reasons, we will contact you to follow up. We also use fines and liaise with Pupil Welfare to motivate excellent attendance for your child's education and well-being.
- Only essential or unavoidable absences will be considered for being authorised.
- Only take holidays in school holidays. See our website for our term dates.
- We must now live with COVID. A cough or a runny nose is not a reason for your child to be absent!

Excellent Behaviour Habits for Home to Support

- We praise children for being excellent learners with rewards such as: house points, certificates, calls home and 'treats.'
- We expect all children to behave well in school. If they do not, we use consequences to help your child to regulate themselves, including: reminders, missed playtimes, detentions and suspensions. We expect parents and carers to support these as we all work to improve your child's behaviour at school.
- We can issue consequences for antisocial behaviour in the community because we want RLA children to behave with integrity, whether they are being watched or not!
