We will also practise re-reading our sentences to edit and improve them using purple pens.





Maths

- Find the tens and ones within a number to 50.



Science

In science, we will be learning about animals including humans. We will describe and compare the structure of a variety of animals. We will also identify and name animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.



Geography

This half term we will be learning all about the United Kingdom. We will also be extending our knowledge of England by exploring the capital, London.



History

This half term, we will be developing our invasion game skills. We will learn some of the principles of attacking and defending and practise our dodging and intercepting skills.


















This half term we will be creating rhythms to classic dance music using rhythm sticks.
