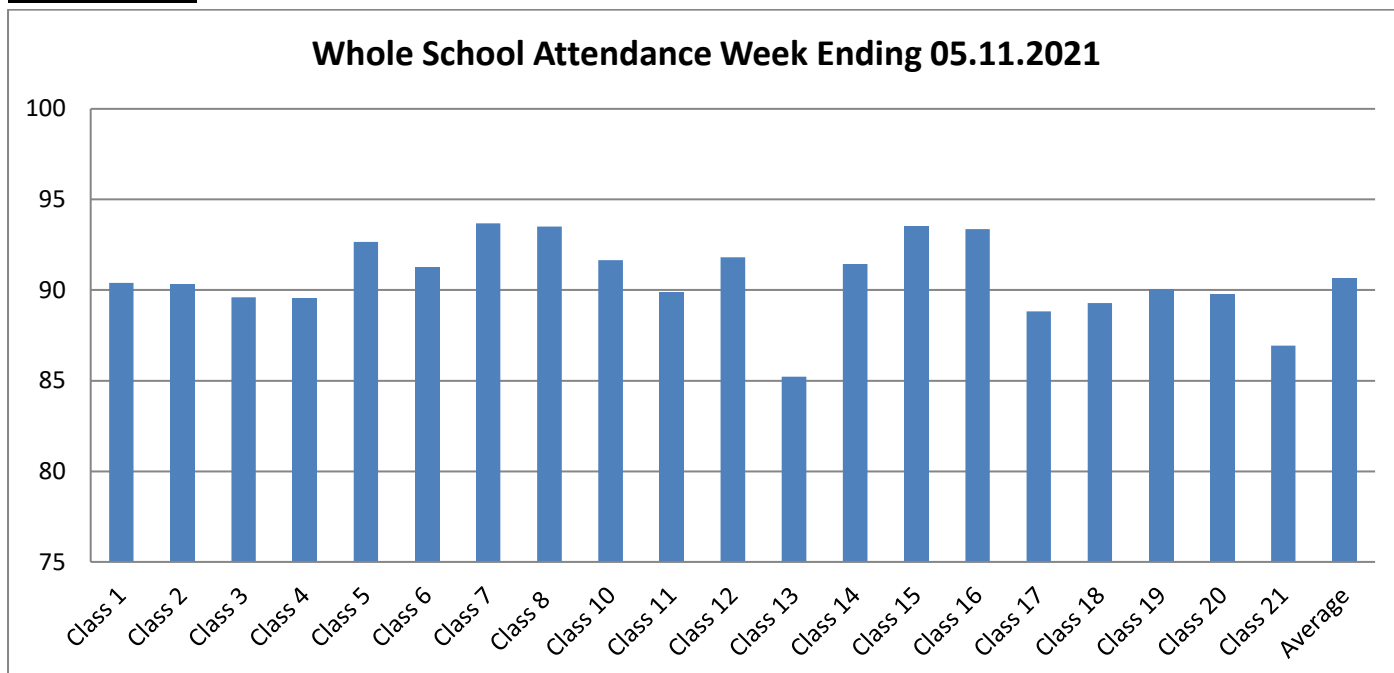




Parent Information Sheet – Thursday 11th November 2021
