


Parent Information Sheet – Thursday 14th December 2023



Attendance



Our target for the academic year is **95.7%.** Look at the graph above to see how your child's class is performing. The average attendance across the school last week was 89.80%, this is below our whole school target and a slight decrease on the previous week.

Authorised absences last week were:

8.90%

Unauthorised absences last week were: **1.30%** - Let's aim to get unauthorised absences to 0% next week. If your child is absent from school, please contact the school office and inform them of the reason.

It is imperative that all absences from school are reported to the school office. This will help to reduce the percentage of unauthorised absences at the school. Failure to report your child's absence from school could result in a prosecution from the educational welfare officer.

NESTA Project

January 2024 is School Meals - Count Me in Month

Monday 8 January - Friday 02 February

We are thrilled to share some exciting news. January 2023 is School Meals - Count Me in Month at Rhiw Syr Dafydd

What are School Meals - Count Me in Month and why is it being run?

Wales leads the UK in rolling out free school lunches to all primary school children, and this now includes every student at Rhiw Syr Dafydd. From Monday 8 January to Friday 02 February, we are partnering with Caerphilly County Borough Council and Nesta, a charity which supports new ideas that improve people's lives, to encourage all our pupils to enjoy their free school meals every day. We believe this initiative could make a positive impact on our children's wellbeing and education, as well as saving families time and money.

We are part of a group of schools in Caerphilly taking part in School Meals - Count Me in Month. There are plans to expand this month to other parts of Wales, so your participation in this research can benefit all children in Wales.

What do I need to do?

We will assume that your child is participating in this initiative and eating a school meal every day from Monday 08 January to Friday 02 February, unless you tell us otherwise.

We really encourage your child to participate if at all possible. However, if you would prefer to opt out, please complete the online opt out form which can be accessed using the following link, bit.ly/3QIyDKg

As school meals are free for all children at Rhiw Syr Dafydd there will be no cost and your child will be automatically registered.

While we understand that some children may have concerns about trying new foods or prefer packed lunches, research suggests that when we collectively embrace new experiences, it can make a positive difference. Each day there are three menu choices and your child will be able to choose their preferred meal.

If your child has unique dietary needs we are not aware of yet, please inform Caerphilly CBC -Special Diet Request by Friday December 15th by emailing catering@caerphilly.gov.uk or by calling the

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catering office at 01443 864055.

We will explain the initiative to the children during a special assembly. Your support in discussing this with your children and reassuring them that it's only for one month and that everyone is taking part would be greatly appreciated.
