


Parent Information Sheet – Thursday 14th October 2021

Over recent days I have become increasingly concerned about the number of pupils re-enacting aspects of 'Squid Games' on the playground. This is an extremely violent program which is currently being broadcast on Netflix and is not suitable to children to watch. The series is certified 15 and primary aged pupils should not be watching the program under any circumstances. I am also aware that 'Squid Games' is also trending on Tik Tok at the current time. Staff have addressed the issue in school and told the pupils they are not to play such games on the playground. I would appreciate parental support with this issue.
