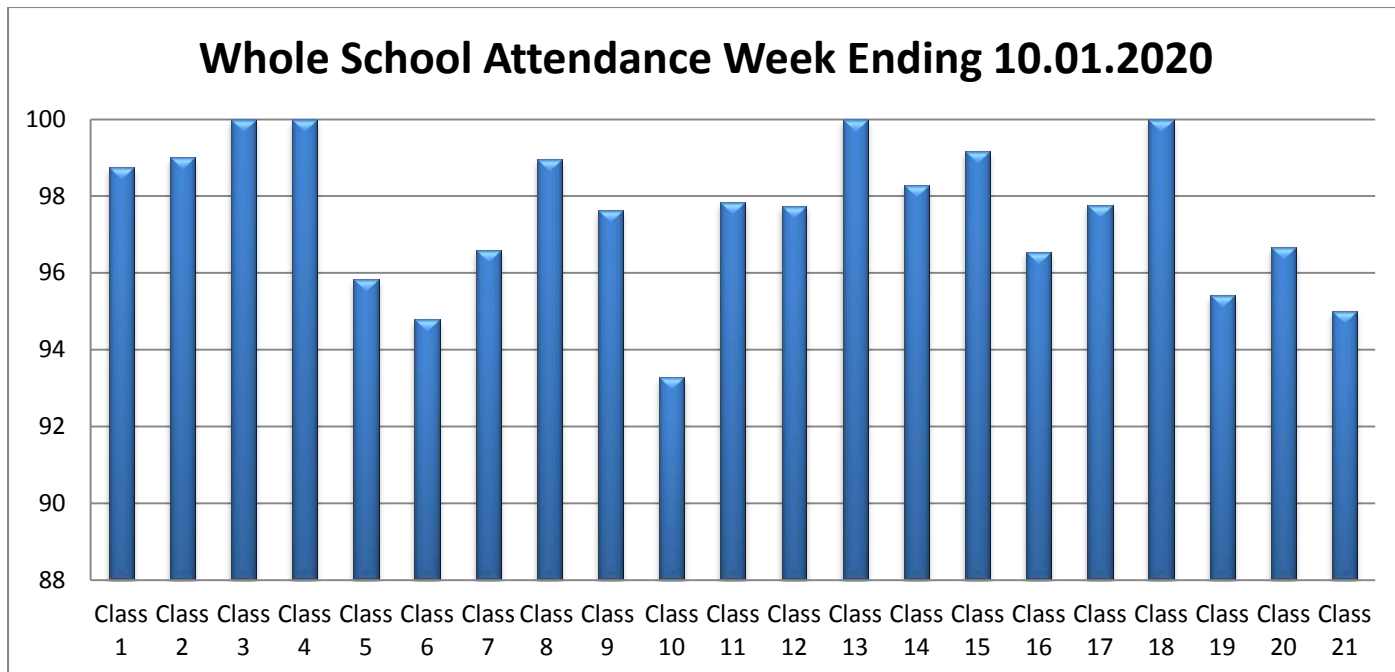




Attendance
