

Thank you

As many of you will be aware, we were forced to close our Nursery class for three days this week due to Coronavirus, as we had no staff available to run the provision. I would like to take this opportunity to thank parents for the support, patience and understanding during this time. It was greatly appreciated.

At times this week, we also came close to having to close other classes due to limited staffing. We are going through a challenging period and it is still extremely important to be vigilant for the symptoms of Coronavirus. If you receive a 'warn and inform' letter from school, you should test your child with an LFT each day for seven days. We hold a supply of LTFs in school for any parents who are not able to source them. Please contact the school office should you require LFTs. If your child tests negative they may continue to attend school. However, if they test positive then they should isolate for a period of seven days.

Gates

There appears to be some confusion as to what time the school gates close each morning. The gates are open and supervised by staff between 8.35am and 8.50am. The gates must close promptly at 8.50am, as staff are required to be in class with the pupils. Any pupil arriving after this time should report to the main reception of the school and signed in by a parent.
