

Our target for the academic year is <u>95.7%.</u> Look at the graph above to see how your child's class is performing. The average attendance across the school last week was **95.10**%, this is slightly below our whole school target but an increase on the previous week. Well done!

Authorised absences last week were: 4.30% Unauthorised absences last week were: 0.70%
