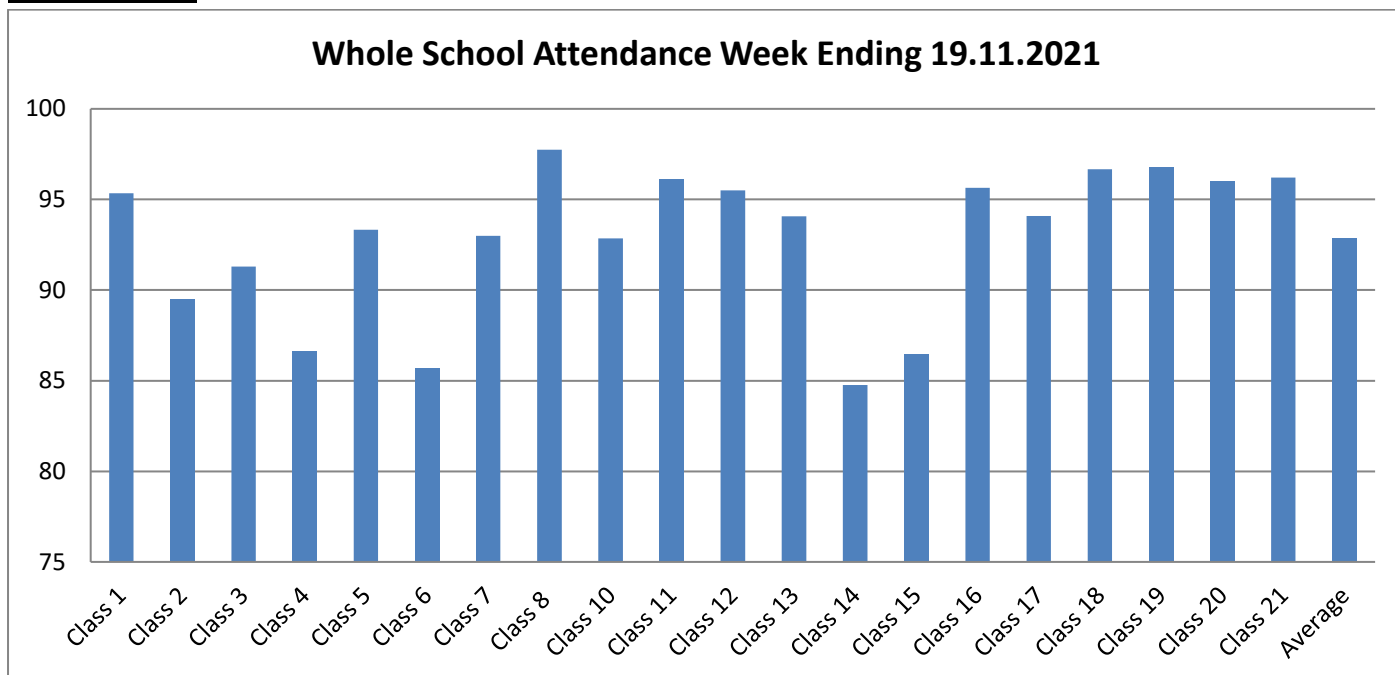




Parent Information Sheet – Thursday 25th November 2021

Covid

It appears that the new Covid rules have caused some confusion. If anyone in your household is displaying any symptoms of Coronavirus or tests positive for Coronavirus the whole household must book a PCR test and self-isolate until the results of the test are received. Any children with a negative result may return to school. However, if the result is positive they must self-isolate for 10 days or the period of time instructed by TTP.

If your child develops symptoms in school, we will contact you to collect that child and any siblings in the school. You will be asked to provide a negative PCR test result before they can return.
