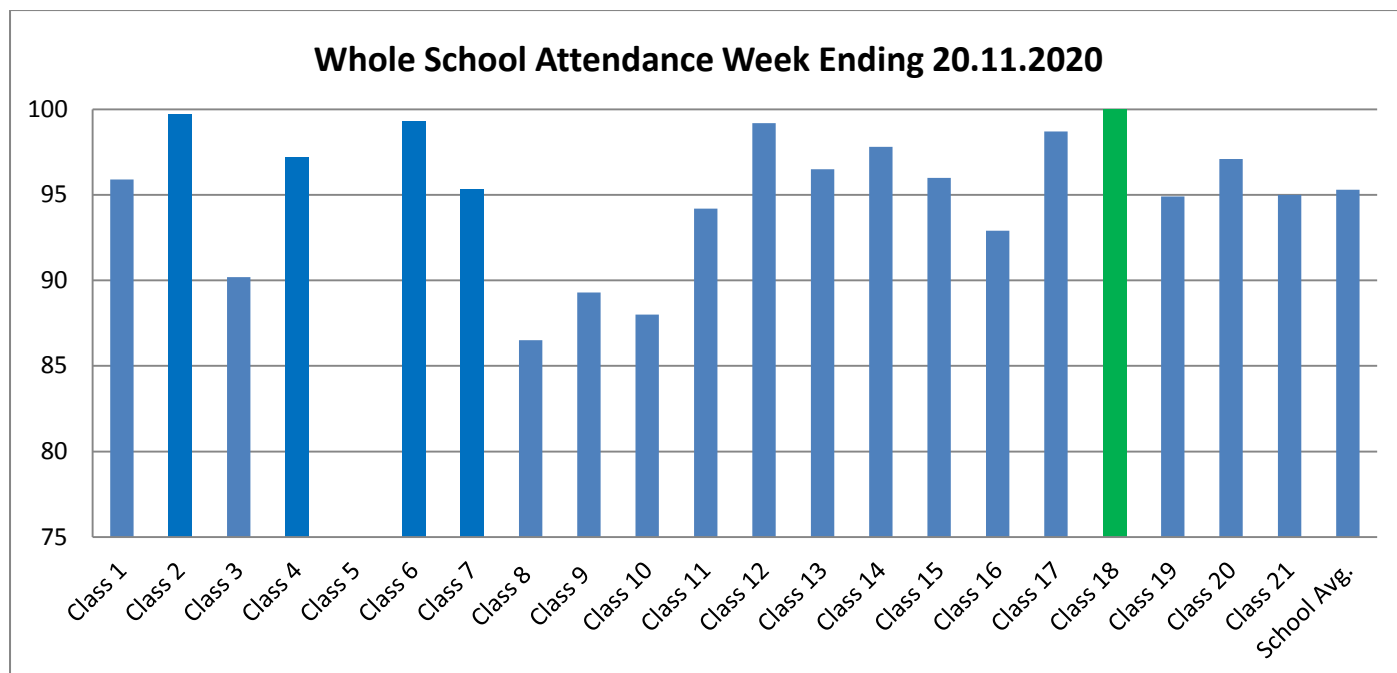




Attendance
