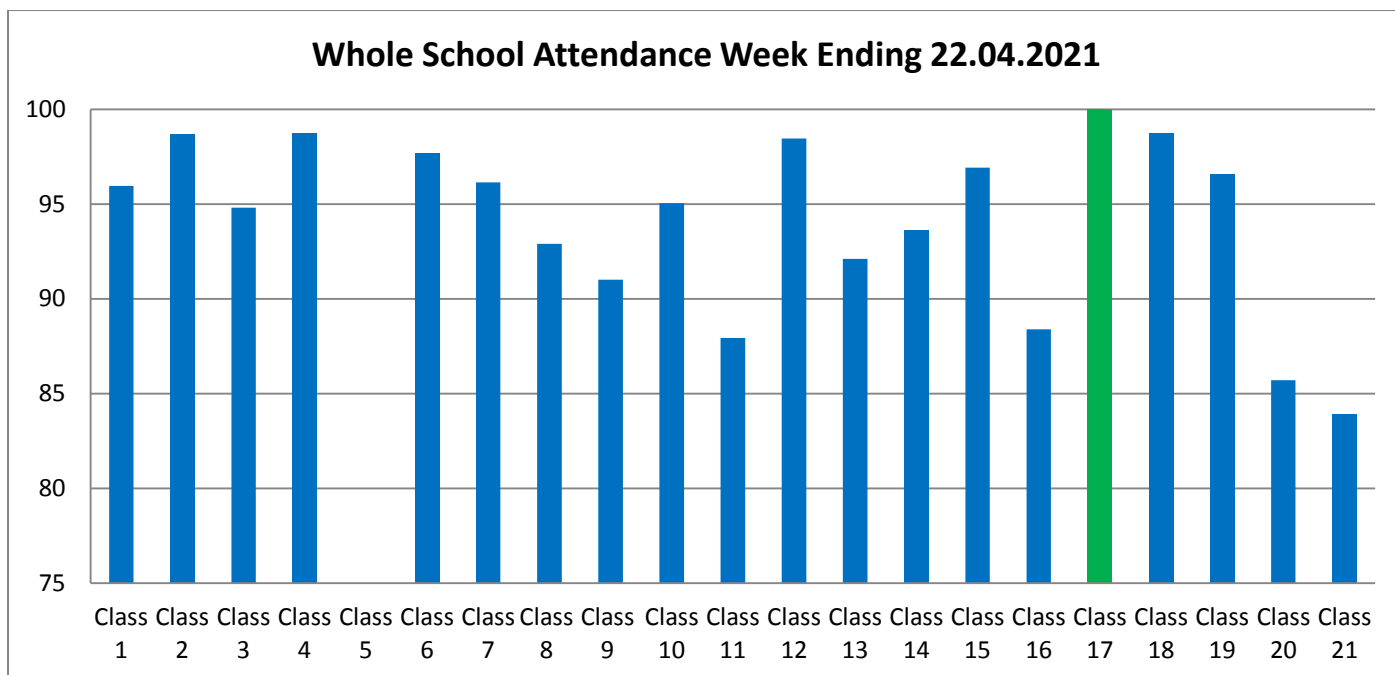




Attendance

Covid-19

The news surrounding Covid-19 is generally quite positive. However, we cannot afford to become complacent now and it is imperative that we all continue to adhere to the rules around Coronavirus. Please wear a mask when bringing or collecting your child and remember to maintain social distance. As we mix more, Covid-19 restrictions remain necessary to stop transmission. As restrictions are eased, getting a test is easy and results are back within hours. Don't gamble with the health of friends and family; if you are feeling generally unwell, it could be Covid-19 - book a test.

In line with the Covid-19 risk assessment, any child displaying symptoms of Coronavirus in school will be sent to the isolation room and parents contacted immediately to collect the child.

All staff continue to undertake the lateral flow tests twice a week to help ensure the safety of everyone attending our school.
