

Our target for the academic year is <u>95.7%</u>. Look at the graph above to see how your child's class is performing. The average attendance across the school last week was **95.10%**, this is just below our whole school target but a slight increase on the previous week.

Authorised absences were: 4.5%

Unauthorised absences were: **0.4% (Well done!)** If your child is absent from school, please contact the school office and inform them of the reason.

It is imperative that all absences from school are reported to the school office. This will help to reduce the percentage of unauthorised absences at the school. Failure to report your child's absence from school could result in a prosecution from the educational welfare officer.

Over the next few weeks we will be closely monitoring the number of children who are persistently late for school. Arriving late for school has a negative impact on well-being and also impacts on learning and teaching in the classroom. Where I identify any concerns, I will be inviting parents into school for a meeting.

Term Time Holidays

Please be aware that all holiday requests are considered on a twelve-month rolling attendance and not just on the current academic year. We will only authorise holidays where the average attendance is 95% or above. In addition, we will only authorise ten days per academic year.
