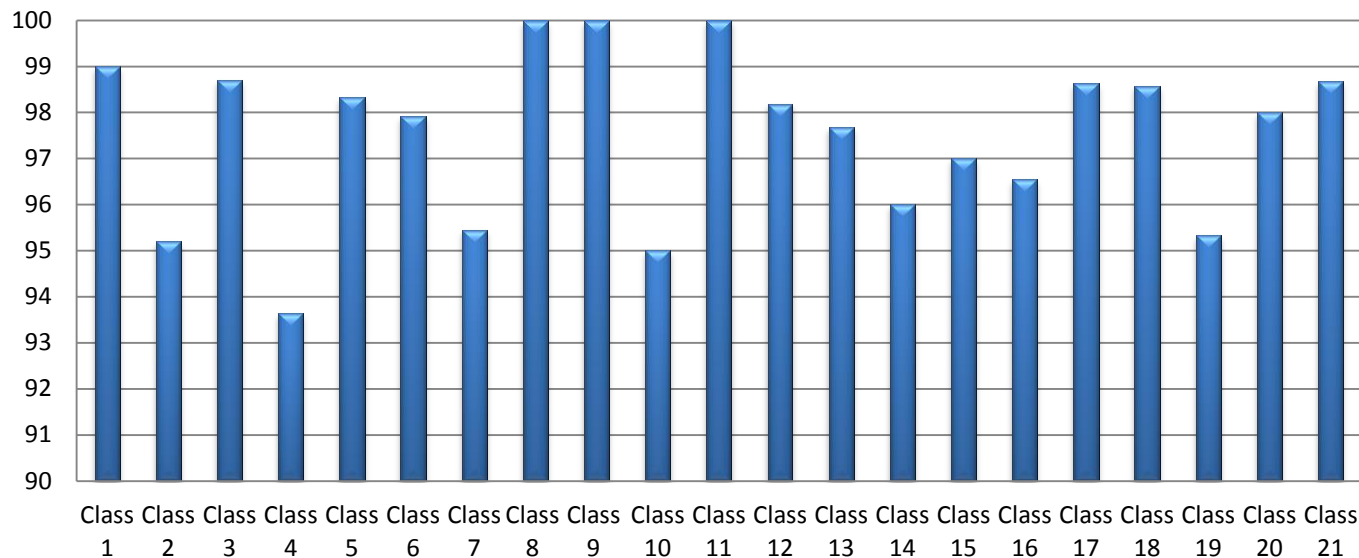




Attendance
