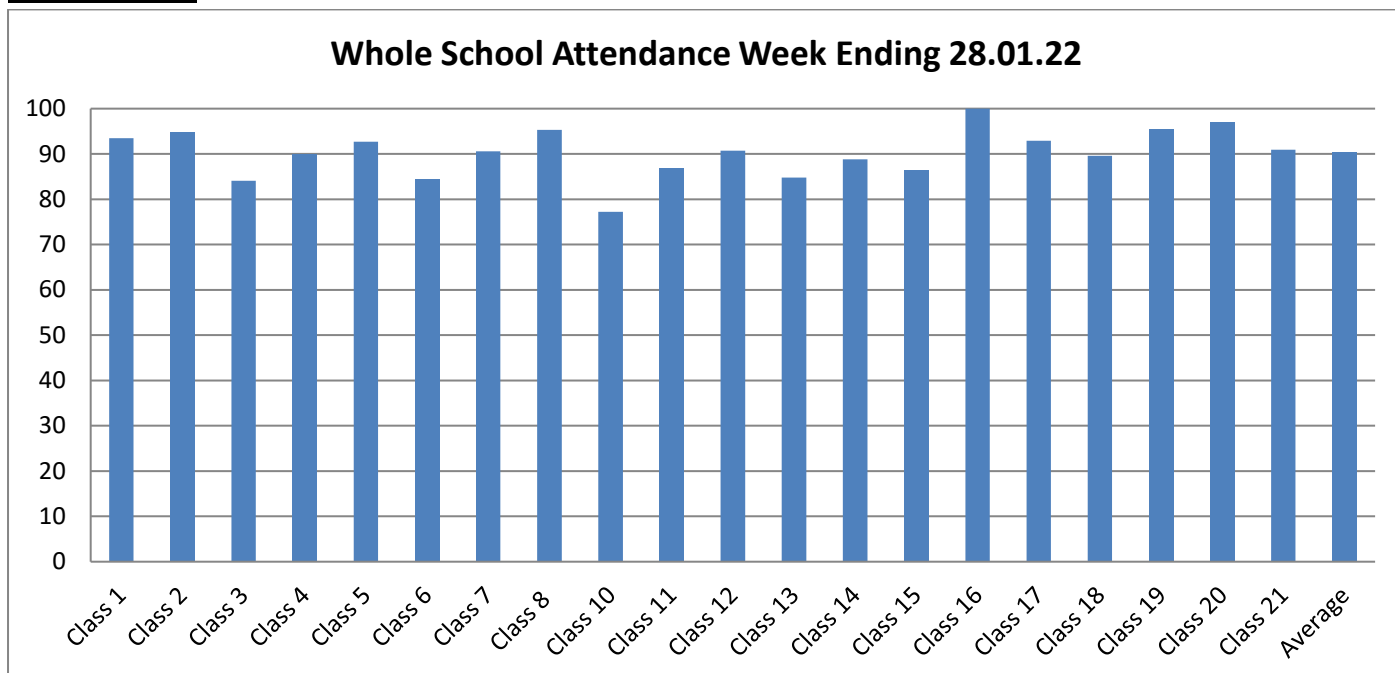




**Parent Information Sheet – Thursday 3rd February 2022**
