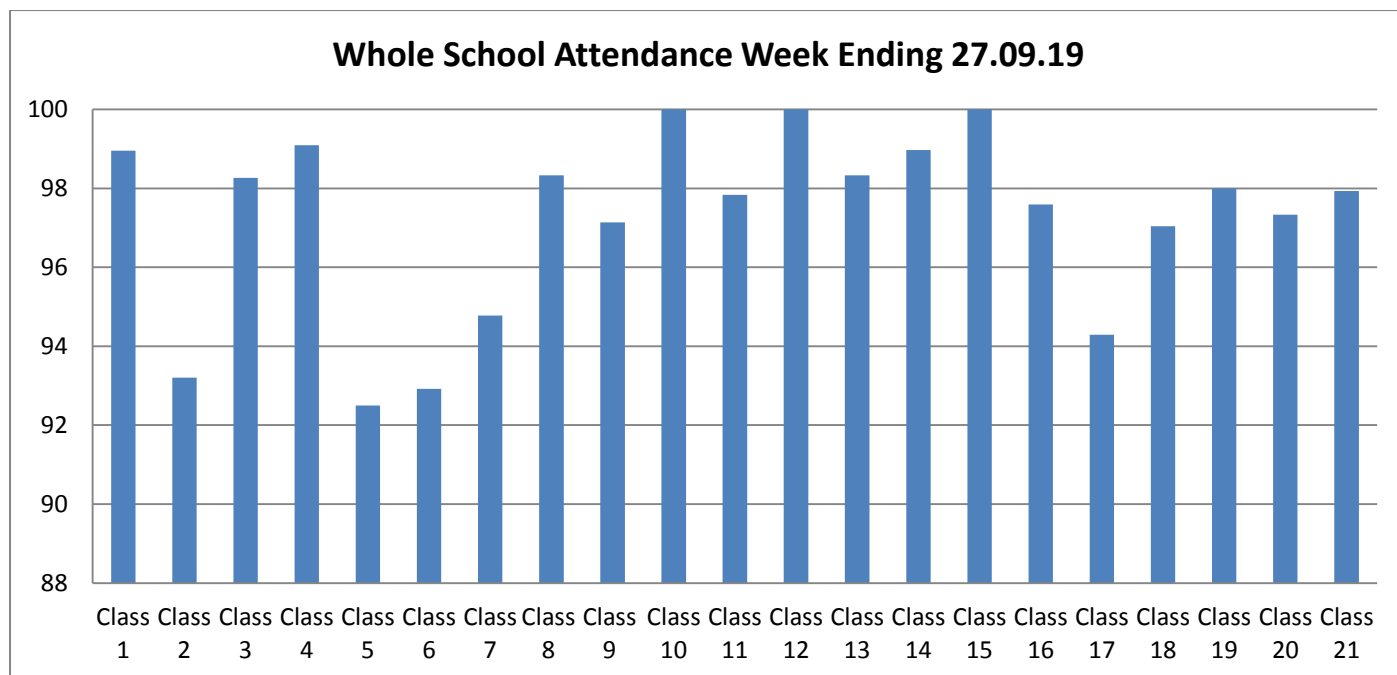




Attendance
