




<u>Parent Information Sheet – Thursday 5th October 2023</u>

Attendance



Our target for the academic year is <u>95.7%.</u> Look at the graph above to see how your child's class is performing. The average attendance across the school last week was 91.8%, this is significantly below our whole school target but a slight increase on the previous week.

School Gates

From Monday 9th October, the school gates will be locked at 8:45am each morning. I have instructed staff that gates must be closed at this time as part of our safeguarding procedures. If you arrive at school after this time you should bring your child to the main reception to sign them in. At the end of the school day, the gates will be opened at 2:50pm.

<u>Jewellery</u>

Over recent days I have noticed an increasing number of pupils wearing hoop earrings. These earrings are not to be worn in school as they pose a health and safety risk. From Monday of next week, I will be speaking to any pupils wearing such earrings.

The only earrings that are permitted in school are stud earrings and your child needs to be able to remove these for physical education lessons. Thank you for your support.

Secondary School Applications

In September 2024, Year 6 children will transfer to Secondary School. To secure a place for your child, you will need to complete an application online.

Please visit the Caerphilly.gov website, search for School Admissions and click to 'Apply for a place at school'. The actual web address is as follows: www.caerphilly.gov.uk/schooladmissions

You **must** complete the form by the **27th October 2023**. Please note, you must include your council tax number on the form. You will find this number on your council tax statement in the top right-hand corner.

Your child's attendance at a feeder Primary/ Junior school does not provide automatic entry into your preferred Secondary school. It is your home address that will determine their catchment school. If your child resides at more than one address (i.e. if there are shared custody arrangements in place), then the address at which the child spends most of the school week should be used.
