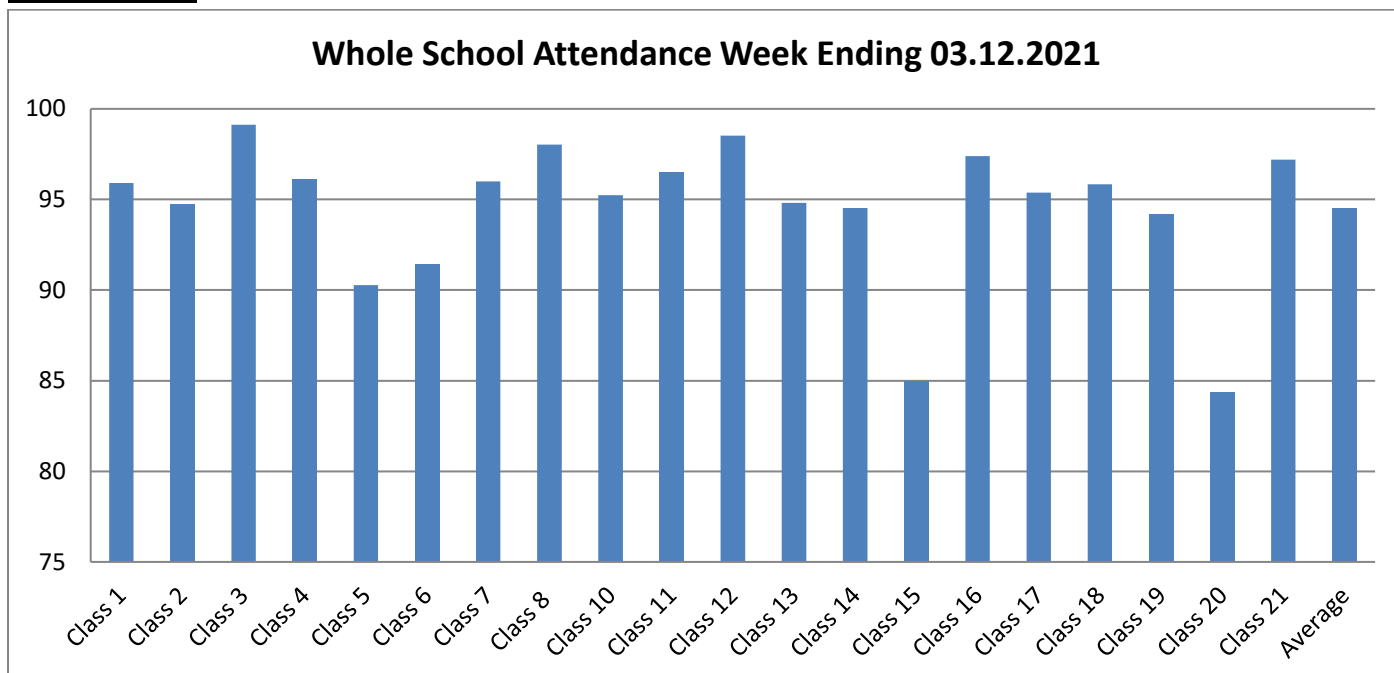


**Parent Information Sheet – Thursday 9th December 2021**

We will also have a visit from some very 'naughty elves' on Monday 13th December. I am sure the children will really enjoy this experience.



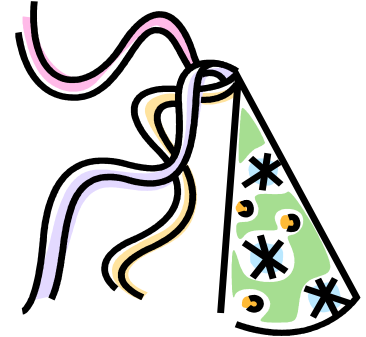
**Christmas Dinner**
