




Parent Information Sheet – Thursday 9th June 2022

Our target for the academic year is **95.7%**. Look at the graph above to see how your child's class is performing. The average attendance was **90.35%**, which is a slight decrease on the previous week. However, we are still below our target of 95.7%. Well done to everyone who has improved their attendance.

Parent Governor

We currently have a vacancy for a Parent Governor position on the school Governing Body. The Role of Governors has become increasingly important. They must ensure that the requirements of the national curriculum are met, establish standards of behaviour, select staff, and deal with budget matters and prepare and present the Annual Report to Parents. Governing Bodies are required to meet at least once a term and most meet after school.

Governors are elected for a four-year term of office, but Parents may continue to serve even if their child leaves the school during that time. Training is continually available for all Governors, at no cost to the individual.
