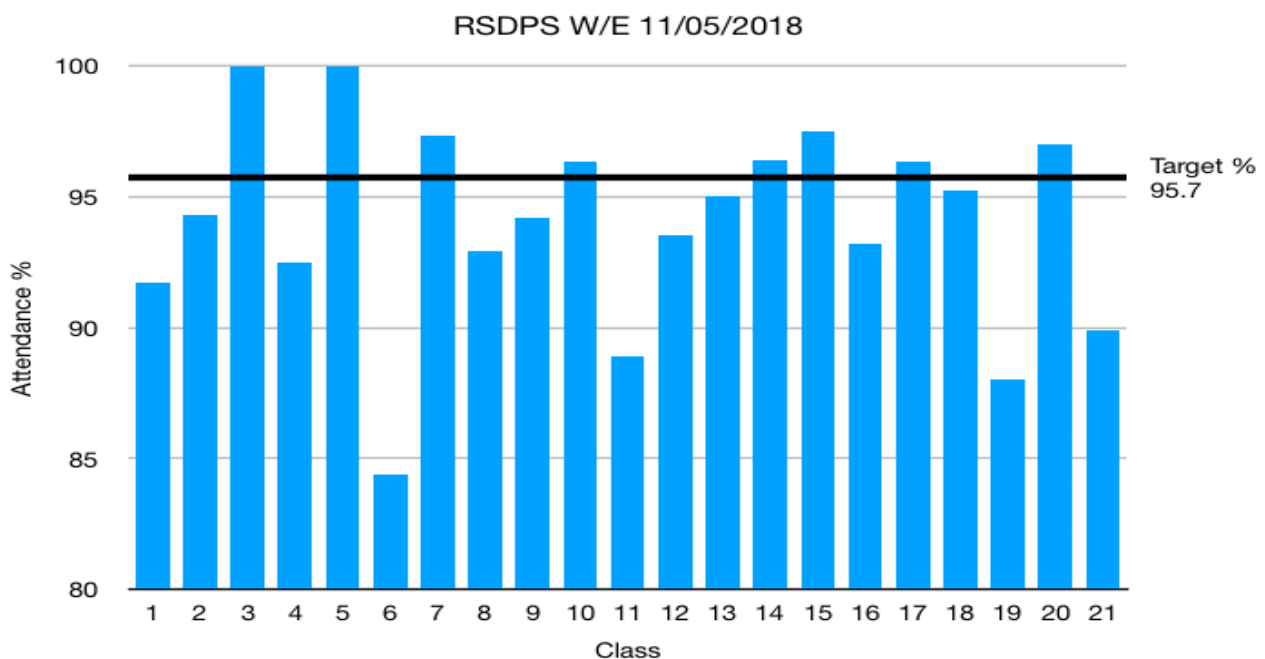




Parent Information Sheet – Tuesday 22nd May 2018

Attendance

Non-Uniform Day

GDPR

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) is the European Union's new framework for data protection laws. It comes into effect on 25 May 2018 and will apply to all organisations, including schools, which process (i.e. store, access and/or collect) personal data. Schools have always held personal data on the students in their care. This data is increasingly held digitally and accessible not just in school but also from remote locations. The GDPR applies to all forms of personal data, whether it is held electronically, in structured manual files, or in paper documents created with the intention that they will form part of a structured manual file.
