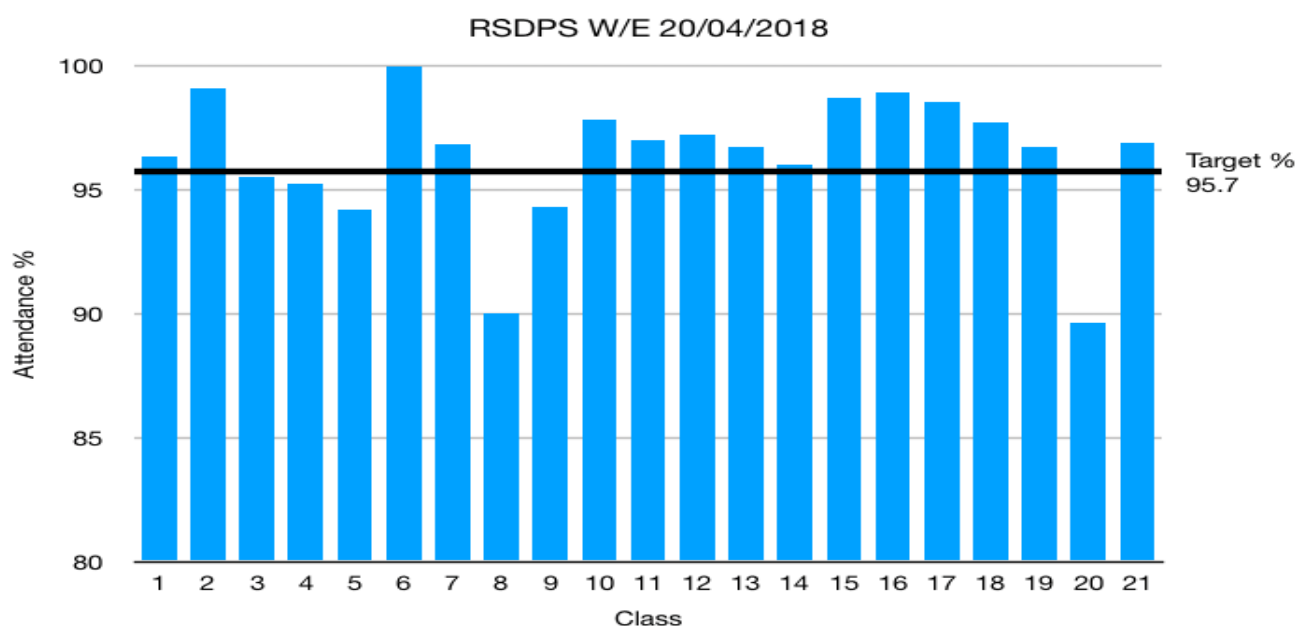




Parent Information Sheet – Thursday 26th April 2018
