


Attendance Matters



Our attendance target for the academic year is <u>95%</u>. Look at the graph above to see how your child's class is performing. The average attendance across the school last week was **89.9%**. This is well below our whole school target and a significant decrease on the previous week.

Authorised absences were: 6.6%

Unauthorised absences were: **3.5%** - <u>This figure is far too high</u>. All absences <u>must</u> be reported to the school office.

It is imperative that all absences from school are reported to the school office. This will help to reduce the percentage of unauthorised absences at the school. Failure to report your child's absence from school could result in a prosecution from the educational welfare officer.

Military Children

The Ministry of Defence Education Support Fund often has grants available to schools. However, schools can only apply if they collate the number of service children attending their schools.

The local authority has an armed forces covenant officer who's aim is to provide the best possible educational support to the children of Armed Forces personnel, by ensuring education professionals understand the issues Service children in Wales may face. By having a strong understanding of the number and location of Service children, the officer can offer schools many free resources and advice to help them support their Service children in the best way possible. They can also highlight to schools any grant schemes they may be eligible for, to fund staff training, purchase resources or pay for additional staff.

As a school, we are seeking to establish how many pupils have parents in the following categories:

- · Navy

- \cdot Reservist
- · Veteran (up to six years after leaving Service)
