# **Reports**

There are a number of parts to the school reports:

- A booklet that tells you how your child has got on this year. This is the booklet with a photograph of your child on the front. It aims to tell you how your child is progressing. The booklet will be different for each child.
- Pupils from Year Two to Year Six will have additional information regarding performance in the National Reading, Procedural and Reasoning Tests. The National Tests provide a snapshot of how a child performed on a particular day under test conditions. It is essential that parents read the results alongside the views of the professionals that have worked with the pupils all year.
- There will be a separate attendance sheet for every child. This will give information on attendance throughout the academic year up until the 7th July 2023. Please remember that a school session is morning and afternoon, therefore there are two sessions a day when pupils may be present.

### **School Uniform**

As we approach the end of the school year, many of you will already be thinking about purchasing new uniform for September. At Rhiw Syr Dafydd we are extremely proud of our school uniform as it gives us a real sense of belonging. I will be closely monitoring school uniform in September. Please remember there is no need to purchase uniform with the school badge as this is often more expensive. Below is the uniform pupils should be wearing to school.

### Foundation Phase and Key Stage 2

- Polo Shirt sky blue with logo
- Knitted jumper navy with logo
- Sweatshirt navy with logo
- School dress navy and white
- Trousers/skirt/slip grey/black During the Summer Term black or grey dress shorts are allowed
- White formal shirt
- Shoes <u>black (trainers are permissible only if black in colour</u>). If pupils wish to wear other trainers for football then these should be brought to school for pupils to change into.

Trainers purchased for school should be black or very dark in colour. Please do not send children to school in brightly coloured footwear.

Reception children are encouraged to follow the whole school uniform policy, however, due to the nature of 'hands on' activities offered; navy jogging bottoms and trainers can be worn.

- Yellow sweatshirt with logo
- Navy jogging bottoms
- Yellow and White school dress

## <u> P.E. Kit</u>

All children **must participate** in P.E. lessons; it is part of the Curriculum for Wales 2022 and therefore is a statutory element of the school curriculum. I will be monitoring this closely in the new academic year.
