


Attendance Matters



Our attendance target for the academic year is <u>95.7%.</u> Look at the graph above to see how your child's class is performing. The average attendance across the school last week was 97.40%, this is above our whole school target

Authorised absences were: 2.10%

Unauthorised absences were: **0.5%** - This is a vast improvement on the previous week. All absences **must** be reported to the school office.

It is imperative that all absences from school are reported to the school office. This will help to reduce the percentage of unauthorised absences at the school. Failure to report your child's absence from school could result in a prosecution from the educational welfare officer.

Secondary School Applications

Applications for secondary school places are now open. To secure a place for your child at secondary school you will need to complete an online application.

The closing date for applications is **25th October 2024.**

Flu Vaccinations

The NHS recommends that your child has a flu vaccination every year.

It's very important to protect your child from flu to make sure they stay as healthy as possible. The best flu vaccine for most children is a nasal spray. This is the vaccine that will be given on the day.

To help make sure the vaccine is suitable for your child, and they don't miss out, please take time to read the information and follow the link to complete the electronic consent form as soon as possible, before the planned vaccination date, no later than 48 hours before the above date.
