


Attendance Matters




Our attendance target for the academic year is <u>95%</u> Look at the graph above to see how your child's class is performing. The average attendance across the school last week was **93.90%** this is below our whole school target but the same as the previous week.

Authorised absences were: 5.4%

Unauthorised absences were: **0.7%** - All absences **must** be reported to the school office.

It is imperative that all absences from school are reported to the school office. This will help to reduce the percentage of unauthorised absences at the school. Failure to report your child's absence from school could result in a prosecution from the educational welfare officer.

As you can see from the chart above, our whole school attendance has gradually improved year on year. However, we still have plenty of work to do. Our attendance for January 2025 was 94.2%, this is below our whole school target but an increase on the same time last year when attendance in January was 93.7%. *Thank you all for your efforts – well done everyone!*

We will be holding our school Eisteddfod on Friday 7th March 2025. On this day, pupils are welcome to come to school in their traditional Welsh outfits. The Eisteddfod is a wonderful celebration of Welsh life, and I very much look forward to seeing the pupils perform.

This year's home / school tasks are as follows:

- Year 5 and 6 will have a photography competition and need to enter a series of 4 colour photographs on the theme of Roots.
- Year 3 and 4 will design a T-Shirt (front on A4 and back on A4, present on A3) to convey any aspect or aspects of the theme Roots.
- **Lower School** will have to create a 2D picture suitable to hang on a wall, using one or combination of these media: Pencil, Ink, Creon, Pastel or Paint to measure no more than 760mm x 560mm.

All of these competitions come directly from the Urdd Eisteddfod 2025 syllabus.
