

Attendance



Our target for the academic year is <u>95.7%.</u> Look at the graph above to see how your child's class is performing. Our average attendance last week was <u>93.20%</u> which is a slight increase on the previous week but still below our whole school target of <u>95.7%</u>. Congratulations to Dosbarth 7 who had the highest attendance last week.

School Essentials Grant (Former PDG Grant)

Key changes for families to be aware of for September 2023

- New name School Essentials Grant replaces the PDG Access Grant
- There is no longer a requirement for families to submit a specific application for the grant. Families of eligible pupils will receive a Post Office letter, allowing collection of a cash payment.
- The grant provides £125 (except for year 7 which is £200) for eligible pupils [Reception through to Year 11] to buy school uniform, equipment, sports kit, and kit for activities outside of school. Please note that the one year only uplift of £100 on the value of the grant has now ended.

Eligibility of pupils remains unchanged, full details are available on the Councils Website.
