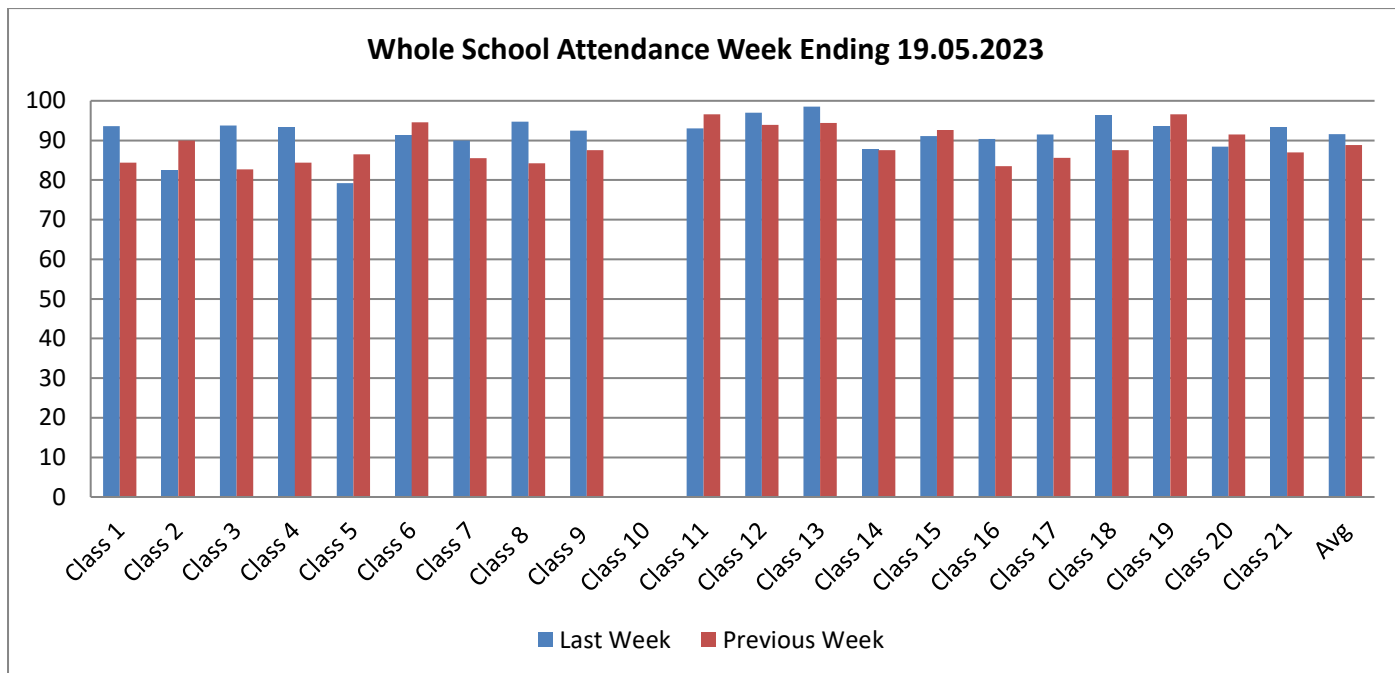




Parent Information Sheet – Thursday 25th May 2023
