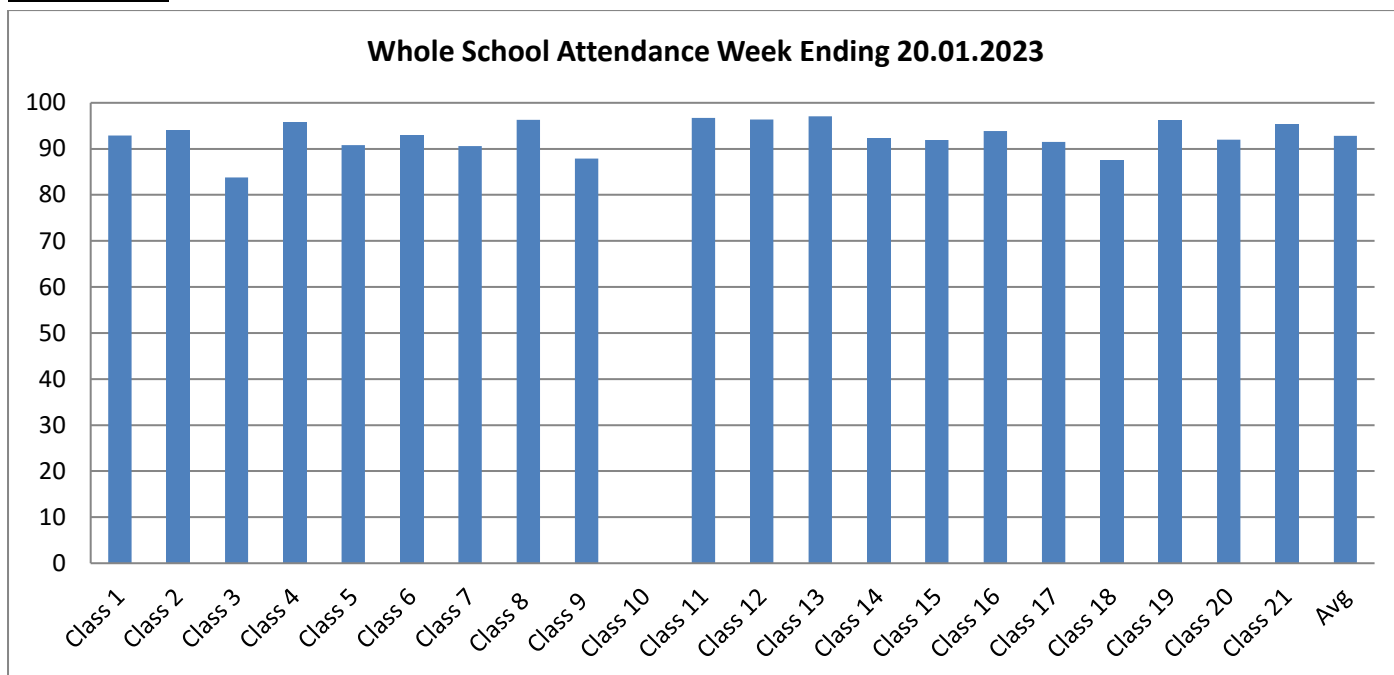




Parent Information Sheet – Friday 27th January 2023

**Attendance**



Our target for the academic year is **95.7%**. Look at the graph above to see how your child's class is performing. Our average attendance the week was **92.8%** which is a slight decrease on the previous week and below our whole school target of **95.7%**.

**Industrial Action**
